- An affordable food menu full of crowd-pleasing pub classics.





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

Schedule for the Railway Tavern

Bar Servery

To complement the new open-plan layout of the pub, the structure of the bar servery will be altered. Works will include:

- Refurbishing the existing bar top.
- Decorating the bar front.
- · Installing feature pendant lights above the servery.
- Painting the bar front in line with the pub's contemporary new look.
- New tiled bar walk.

Bar Area

In line with the pub's new contemporary look and feel, the bar area will be overhauled. Works will include:

- Sand existing flooring and laying some new sections.
- Installing multiple flat-screen TVs.
- Adding sections of fixed seating, upholstered in a rich, polished leather finish.
- Addition of a variety of mid-height furniture such as sharing tables, wooden chairs and vintage stools upholstered in vibrant tweeds and leather.
- Adding quirky bric-a-brac, framed artwork and vibrant plants to add character to the new venue.

Dining Area

The bar and dining area will be revamped and redecorated to create a comfortable and practical open-plan space with a modern, rustic look. Works will include:

- Installing striking copper and glass pendant lights over dining tables to create a relaxing atmosphere.
- Adding a variety of furniture to the area, including upcycled sharing tables, vintage wooden chairs and fixed seating upholstered in polished leather.
- Laying new carpets.
- Hanging new curtains on the windows.
- Painting the area in warm and cosy neutral tones.
- Fitting ambient sidelights.

Kitcher

The Railway Tavern's existing kitchen will offer a wide range of family-friendly meals in an efficient manner.

Snug

The snug will create a relaxed space for customers looking to enjoy a casual drink or bite to eat. Works will include:

- Introducing barrel chairs.
- Decorating the space with characterful bric-a-brac and colourful artwork.
- Laying a new carpet.
- Adding dining tables and chairs finished in polished wood and vibrant tweed.

Toilets

Both the ladies' and the gents' toilets will be deep-cleaned and redecorated to reflect the new feel of the Railway Tavern. Works will include:

- Replacing all urinals.
- Laying new timber-look vinyl flooring to the ladies'.
- Redecorating the toilets to complement the new aesthetic.
- Finishing the space with ambient lighting and contemporary, framed mirrors.

External Areas

To capitalise on the Railway Tavern's prominent location, the external areas will be enhanced to attract passing trade. Works will include:

- Installing new picnic benches, signage scheme and vibrant potted plants to increase kerb appeal.
- Deep-cleaning of all existing ground coverings.
- Expanding the garden area to create a vibrant outdoor beer garden for up to 60 customers to drink and dine alfresco during the warmer months.
- Refurbishing existing benches with a new stain.
- Adding new loose furniture to increase covers.
- Repainting the lower facades of the pub in a pleasing pastel blue colour.
- Adding new lighting including lanterns and floodlighting to illuminate the pub's entrance while improving its evening kerb appeal.
- Painting the pub's amenities directly onto the walls.
