ANNEX 1
Mandatory Conditions

SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL (Section 19)

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence -

- A. at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of it; or
- B. at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol made under this premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

EMBEDDED RESTRICTIONS

All conditions which reproduce the effect of any restriction imposed on the use of the premises for the existing licensable activities under the relevant existing licence or licences or under any enactment specified for the purposes of schedule 8 of the Licensing Act 2003, as issued by the Department of Culture, Media and Sport in May 2005.

CONSISTENT WITH FORMER CHILDRENS CERTIFICATE DATED 10.08.00

The premise has an area suitable for persons under fourteen, accompanied by an adult, to be present and that meals and beverages other than intoxicating liquor is available for sale for consumption in that area. The Certificate operates daily between 12.00 & 20.00.

ANNEX 2

Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. All external doors and windows in the premises must be closed when there is regulated entertainment that may give rise to a public nuisance (as defined in section 7.40 of the Guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003), except for the duration of access and egress or in an emergency.
2. Persons under the age of 18 are not permitted to remain on the premise after 21.00.
3. The use of the beer garden will cease at 23.00.
4. A representative of the premise will attend the local Pubwatch.
