

Exciting Opportunity: Pleasant Retreat, Lostock Hall Pub Refurbishment!

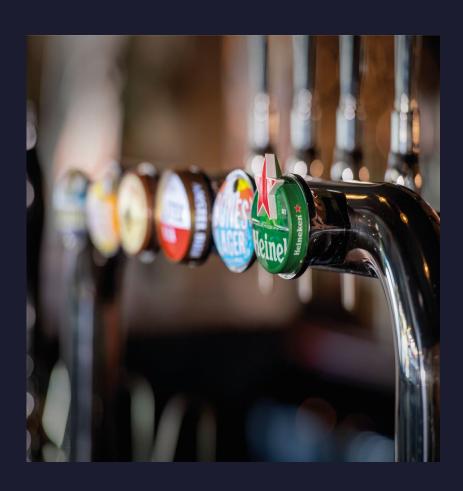

#### **Local Games Fans:**

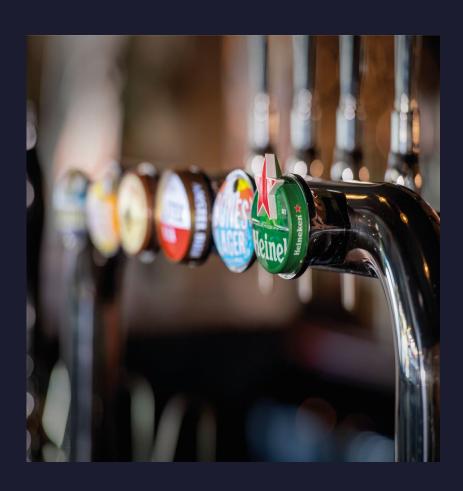
 Locals who come for darts, quizzes and other community entertainment in the bar and games room, drawn by a lively yet welcoming vibe.

#### Coffee:


• Coffee can be offered, attracting daytime visitors and non-drinkers, broadening the pub's appeal.

 Pool and darts, regular quiz & bingo nights, plus occasional local live entertainment to drive a strong rhythm of the week.





### Floor Plans & Finishes




