## **Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions**

### **Supply of alcohol**

#### **Licensing Act 2003 Section 19**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence –
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

## **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule**

- **Provision of a CCTV surveillance system with recording facilities. Images to be available to the police on request.**
- **No irresponsible drinks promotions.**
- **No person in possession of a drink in a sealed or unsealed container shall be allowed to enter the premises except for the purposes of delivery.**
- **There shall be displayed at the entrance to the premises a sign, which is clearly visible to members of the public visiting those premises containing details of the trading hours under the premises licence, the licensable activities permitted on those premises and any maximum occupancy level set for the premises.**
- **All fire doors shall be maintained effectively self-closing and shall not be held open other than by approved devices.**
- **Notices to be displayed in a prominent position detailing the actions to be taken in the event of fire or other emergency, including how the fire brigade shall be summoned.**
- **No drink shall be sold from a bar or by staff service for consumption in the external drinking area other than in a container made from non-splintering plastic, paper or shatterproof glass.**
- **No one under the age of 18 shall be admitted to the premises or allowed to remain on the premises after 21:00 save for Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.**
- **The children's play area shall close at 22:30.**
- **There shall be in place for the premises a written policy to prevent the sale or supply of alcohol to persons under 18 years of age. That policy shall require any person who appears to be under the age of 21 years to produce a recognised proof of age card, accredited under the Proof of Age Standards (PASS) or if a proof of age card is not available a photo driving licence or passport.**
- **Hot food shall be available between the hours of 06:00 and 08:00 to non-resident customers.**
- **The licence holder and/or the designated premises supervisor or a person nominated by them shall be a member of and regularly attend at the meetings of the Pub Watch scheme for the area within which the premises is located.**
- **All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except for access and egress and in the event of an emergency.**

- The Licence Holder or his representative shall conduct regular assessments of the noise coming from the premises on every occasion the premises are used for regulated entertainment and shall take steps to reduce the level of noise where it is likely to cause a disturbance to local residents. A written record shall be made of those assessments in a logbook kept for that purpose and shall include, the time and date of the checks, the person making them and the results including any remedial action.
- There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public, notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly. This includes a reference to vehicles.
- The Licence Holder shall provide a sound level limiter within the area in which regulated entertainment takes place. The level at which the limiter shall operate shall be set in conjunction with the Borough Council's Environmental Health Officer.
- Embedded restrictions under the Licensing Act 1964 as listed and approved by DCMS guidance to the extent that they have not been varied on this Licence.
