



Annexe 1 – Mandatory Conditions

<p>Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol</p>	<p>(1) Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions.</p> <p>(1) The first condition is that no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, orb) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended. <p>(2) The second condition is that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.</p>

Annexe 2 – Conditions consistent with your Operating Schedule

- No irresponsible sales of alcoholic beverages shall be offered to customers.
- No customers carrying open or sealed bottles shall be admitted to the premises at any time the premises are open to the public.
- All fire doors will be maintained effectively self closing and shall not be held open.
- Notices detailing the actions to be taken in the event of fire or other emergencies, including how the fire brigade shall be summoned are to be prominently displayed.
- No regulated entertainment of any type shall take place outside the premises in any areas which are within the license holders control after 22:00 save for any special event seven days notice of which has been given to the licensing authority and police.
- A sign will be located at the exits requesting customers leaving the premises to do so quietly and with consideration to neighbours.
- No one under the age of 16 will be allowed to enter or remain on the premises after 22.00 save on Christmas Eve and New Years Eve.
- Anyone who appears to be under the age of 18 and who is attempting to buy alcohol must be required to produce proof of age before such a sale is made.
- Live Music only permitted to be played towards the rear of the premises.
- All windows and internal doors to be kept closed whilst Live Music is played.

Annexe 3 – Conditions attached after hearing by the Licensing Authority

- All windows and doors to be closed by 9.00pm
- The premises shall promote the use of taxi firms that provide a call back service.
- Bottles or broken glasses shall not be disposed of from the premises between the hours of 9.00pm and 9.00am so as not to cause a disturbance to residents in the vicinity of the premises.


