**If this premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the following conditions must be complied with:**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence—
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence
3. The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises—

- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
  - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
  - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
- (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).

4. The responsible person shall ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
5. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
6. The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—

- (a) a holographic mark, or
- (b) an ultraviolet feature.

7. The responsible person must ensure that—

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—

- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

8. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

**If this premises licence authorises the exhibition of films, the admission of children to the exhibition of any film must be restricted in accordance with this condition**

9. Where the film classification body is specified in the licence, unless section b) below applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that body.

Where—

- (a) the film classification body is not specified in the licence, or
- (b) the relevant licensing authority has notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question,

admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that licensing authority.

**If this premises licence requires the use of door supervisors.**

10. Where the premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, each such individual must

- (a) be authorised to carry out that activity by a licence granted under the Private Security Industry Act 2001; or
- (b) be entitled to carry out that activity by virtue of section 4 of that Act.

Note: This does not apply to premises with premises licences authorising plays or films, premises exclusively used by a club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence .

## **Explanatory Notes and Definitions for Mandatory Condition 8.**

### Definitions

“duty” is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;

“permitted price” is the price found by applying the formula—

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

where—

- (i) P is the permitted price,
- (ii) D is the rate of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

“relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—

- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
- (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
- (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

“valued added tax” means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

Where the permitted price calculated would not be a whole number of pennies, it shall be taken to be the price calculated rounded **up** to the nearest penny.

## **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

In order to further the licensing objectives the licensee reserves the right to move fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines and or any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location which may impact on the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routes without impediment.

Pub Watch member.

All new staff go through induction programme covering: Drugs awareness, underage drinking and alcohol abuse, fire safety, hourly toilet checks.

Air extractor in both bars

Emergency lighting throughout pub.

Illuminated exit signs.

Holders of the following certificates: Health & Safety; Health & Hygiene; Fire certificate.

Fire fighting equipment throughout the pub.

No smoking bar, and designated no smoking areas.

Double glazing in the bar.

Amplified music turned down after 22:30.

No adjoining local residents (nearest residents over 100 metres from the pub).

No other public houses in the vicinity.

No entertainment of an adult nature.

Under 18s accompanied by an adult allowed in the lounge (non-smoking) and must be off the premises by 21:00.

Both gaming machines located in the bar area which is out of bounds to under 18s.

No Music to be permitted in the outside areas and the existing external speaker be removed

The following schedule applies for Sale of Alcohol, Provision of Live & Recorded Music, Dancing and Late Night Refreshment (as applicable )

11:00 to 23:00 Monday to Thursday

11:00 to 01:00 Friday and Saturday

12 Noon to 12 midnight on Sunday

The times may be extended by one hour on Friday, Saturday and Sunday of Bank Holiday Weekends including Easter, May Day, Whitsun, August Bank Holiday, Christmas Eve and Boxing Day

From the start of permitted hours on New Years Eve until the end of permitted hours on New Years Day

The Premises to be closed to the public 30 minutes after the last permitted sale of alcohol.

The Pub Manager to be required to actively participate in and support the local Pub Watch Scheme (where active)

No promotions which encourage illegal, irresponsible or immoderate consumption of alcohol

CCTV to be installed and maintained outside the premises and be operated in accordance with the Data protection Act, recordings to be kept for a period of 31 days

Alcohol sold for consumption in the outside drinking area will be served in plastic containers after 20:00hrs and in any event, when the licensing objective is likely to be compromised.

The appropriate amount of S.I.A registered door staff/security will be employed at the premises in order to have sufficient security staff in place to prevent the licensing objective being compromised.

The premises will be operated in an effective and responsible manner in order to promote the licensing objective.

Licensing activities will cease when the licensing objective is or is likely to be compromised.
