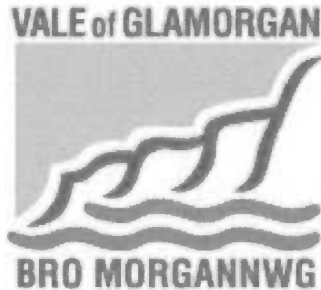

ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Supply of Alcohol (on or off sales)

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence, or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Minimum Pricing (On and Off Sales)

1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1-

(a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979

(<<http://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukdsi/2014/9780111113998>>);

(b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula-

$P = D + (D \times V)$ <http://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukdsi/2014/9780111113998/images/ukdsi_9780111113998_en_001>

where-

(i) P is the permitted price,

(ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and

(iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

(c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence-

(i) the holder of the premises licence,

(ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or

(iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

(d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

(e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994 (<<http://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukdsi/2014/9780111113998>>).

3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.

4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Irresponsible Drinks Promotions (On Sales)

1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises-

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-

(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;

(d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;

(e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).

Free drinking water (On Sales)

The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

Age verification Policy (Off sales)

(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-

(a) a holographic mark, or

(b) an ultraviolet feature.

Smaller Measures (On sales)

The responsible person must ensure that-

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-

(i) beer or cider: ½ pint;

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available."

ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

CCTV in place.

Car Park well lit.

Exterior of building patrolled when live music is being played with decibel monitor.

Live music provided through noise limiter.

The premises will not engage in any irresponsible drink promotions that encourage binge drinking.

Licensee involved in Pub watch.

Emergency lighting and illuminated signs.

Health and safety and risk assessment logs held.

The premises will operate a robust anti-drink spiking procedures

No children allowed on the premises after 21.00 unless partaking of a substantial meal or attending a private function.

ANNEX 3 - CONDITIONS ATTACHED AFTER A HEARING BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY**Capacity and Safe Condition of Premises**

1. No overcrowding in any part of the premises which would interfere the safety or comfort of the public shall be permitted.

Play Equipment

2. No inflatable play equipment shall be used without prior consent of the Licensing Authority. If agreement is given, conditions of use may apply.

Refuse Storage

3. Refuse and bottle storage areas and/or bins shall be secured to prevent unauthorized access. Thus glass bottles held in areas accessible to the public could not be used as weapons.

Heating and Ventilation

4. The premises shall be adequately ventilated in all areas which the staff and public have access so as to enable doors and windows to remain closed thereby enabling the premises to reduce the likelihood of a public nuisance to nearby residents caused by the breakout of noise due to entertainment.

Noise

5. All reasonably practicable shall be taken to prevent a nuisance at any neighbouring properties, during and outside the hours of operation.

6. Clearly legible notices shall be displayed at all exits from the premises requesting public, members, guests and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.

7. All refuse and bottles shall be disposed of in bins quietly so as not to disturb neighbours or local residents. There shall be no disposal of glass bottles and refuse outside between 23.00 hours and 08.00 hours nor any movement of equipment or materials so as to be audible from the curtilage of the nearest sensitive premises.

8. Measures shall be in place to ensure that all staff are aware that waste should only be put out at the appropriate time and that this includes verbal instructions to staff.

9. The designate premises supervisor shall request that deliveries, collections and operational servicing are carried out at reasonable hours such as after 08.00 am and not after 19.00 pm, except where access at other times is unavoidable and specific procedures are in place to limit disturbance.

10. Guidance shall be given by the designated premises supervisor to drivers to switch off engines during deliveries, collections and servicing, and to minimise other noise caused by their activities.

11. Entertainment shall be held within the envelope of the building only and no music or speech shall be relayed externally. No loudspeakers/amplifiers for regulated entertainment shall be provided to external areas such as beer gardens or the fore court of the premises.

12. Coolers for cellars any other compressors for refrigeration equipment sited externally shall be located within acoustic enclosures.

13. The noise level from the premises whilst being used for regulated entertainment purposes shall be inaudible at the curtilage of the nearest sensitive premises.




