ANNEX 1

MANDATORY LICENSING CONDITIONS

1. Section 19 of the Act provides that where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions:
 - (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence; or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
 - (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

2. Section 19A of the Act provides that where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, the licence must include the following conditions:
 - (1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises -
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to -
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
 - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
 - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
3. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
4.
 - (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The Designated Premises Supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the

supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either -

- (a) a holographic mark, or
- (b) an ultraviolet feature.

5. The responsible person must ensure that:

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:

- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125ml;

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

6. (1) A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

(2) For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph (1) -

(a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;

(b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula $P = D + (D \times V)$ where -

- (i) P is the permitted price,
- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of Value Added Tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the Value Added Tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence,
 - (ii) the Designated Premises Supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
 - (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
 - (e) "Value Added Tax" means Value Added Tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
- (3) Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph (2) would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- (4) (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph (2) on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or Value Added Tax.
- (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

ANNEX 3 - CONDITIONS ATTACHED AFTER A HEARING BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY

1. The Licence holder or his representative shall on every occasion the premises are used for regulated entertainment check external noise levels at regular intervals to ensure that sound levels are reasonable and not affecting noise sensitive premises. Appropriate steps should be taken to reduce the level of noise where it is likely to cause a disturbance to local residents. Where a complaint is made either to the management or via the Local Authority, a written record shall be made of those noise assessments in a log book for a period of three months following the complaint. The details recorded shall include the time and date of the checks, the person making them and the results, including any remedial action. This written log shall be available for inspection by the Local Authority.

2. Refuse, ie bottle sorting/disposal, shall not take place outside between 10pm and 8am.
3. Customers should be reminded to leave quietly by regular announcements from the DJ during entertainment events and by door supervisors or members of staff as they are leaving the premises.
4. All licensing functions will be carried out in a way that ensures public safety and the protection of children from harm. There will be sensitivity to the potential impact on local residents and businesses and residents will be protected from detrimental effects.
5. All members of management will be trained to effectively supervise staff and ensure that the premises are operated in such a manner as to prevent crime and disorder, protect the safety of the public and children from physical harm.
6. A daily incident book detailing all incidents on the premises or in the immediate vicinity, eg slips, accidents, entry refusals and incidents of disorder will be maintained and made available for up to six months to the police.
7. Signs will be prominently displayed at the exits to the premises asking people to leave quietly and to have regard for residential neighbours.
8. Information will be provided about local taxis to assist customers to return home.
9. When entertainment is being provided, external doors and windows will be kept closed at all times.
10. Under 18s will have a non-smoking area and persons under 18 will be kept away from smoking areas.
11. Gaming machines will be located within sight of the bar.
12. Notices stating "No Under 18s Allowed to Play" will be prominently displayed.
13. Notices stating "It is illegal for persons under 16 to purchase cigarettes" will be prominently displayed.
14. The grounds of the premises shall be maintained in a tidy and litter free state.
15. No customers will be allowed to take open bottles, cans or glasses (either glass or plastic) off site. Any sales of alcohol specifically for off site consumption shall be sold in sealed containers.
