Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

1 Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence:
 - a) At a time that there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence; or
 - b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 1A - Embedded Restrictions

1. For the purpose of paragraph 6(8) of Schedule 8 to the Licensing Act 2003 this licence is subject to the effect of restrictions contained in the Licensing Act 1964 and the Children and Young Persons Act 1933, which include, but may not be limited to, the following:
 - i) Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during the hours authorised under this licence, however this restriction does not prohibit:
 - a) During the first twenty minutes after the authorised hour, the taking of alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
 - b) Consumption of alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale of supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
 - c) The ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the dispatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
 - d) The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
 - e) The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;
 - f) The taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there;
 - g) The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
 - h) The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, if the alcohol is supplied at the expenses of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

GENERAL

30-minute drink up time will allow appropriate dispersal and use of lavatories.

All exit doors within the premises shall be easily open able without the use of a key, card, code or similar means

THE PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

The designated premises supervisor shall not promote or encourage irresponsible drinks promotions or discounting of prices for alcoholic beverages.

The premises licence holder or club official or persons acting under their authorisation shall ensure that the emergency lighting is not altered.

S.I.A. Registered door supervisors shall be provided to carry out searches on persons and to exclude those who may be carrying illegal drugs or offensive weapons when the premises is hosting formalised publicity advertised dancing and entertainment e.g. an advertised public event for which a DJ has been appointed.

CCTV covering areas inside and outside of club should be updated/maintained to police recommendations with properly maintained log arrangements and tapes, if used, kept for 31 days in a secure cabinet on the premises. CCTV is to comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 and is to be working and recording correctly when the premises is open to the public. A staff member from the club that is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system will be on the premises at all times that the club is open to the public. This staff member will be able to show police recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested. This data footage reproduction should be almost instantaneous.

Police in consultation with the licence holder or designated premises supervisor, shall determine whether door security is required on a more regular basis, taking into account crime and disorder issue that may become apparent at the premises. E.g. drugs dealing/usage or regular disorder. The police decision will be final.

PUBLIC SAFETY

Adequate arrangements shall be in place to enable the safe evacuation of disabled visitors in the event of an emergency and that disabled visitors are made aware of these arrangements.

The premises licence holder or club official or persons acting under their authorisation shall ensure that all emergency lighting batteries are fully charged before the admission of the public, members or guests into the premises and shall ensure that in the event of a failure of normal lighting, where the emergency lighting battery has a capacity of one hour, arrangements are in place to ensure that the public, members or guests leave the premises within 20 minutes unless within that time normal lighting has been restored and the batteries are being re-charged. If the emergency lighting battery has a capacity of 3 hours, the premises should be vacated within 1 hour.

The premises licence holder or persons acting under their authorisation shall ensure an adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials is available on the premises.

THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

The premises licence holder or club official or persons acting under their authorisation shall ensure that the music system is fitted with a noise limiter so as to ensure that a nuisance is not caused to nearby premises.

The premises licence holder or club official or persons acting under their authorisation shall ensure that the lobby doors to the premises shall be maintained as lobby doors and not wedged open.

The premises licence holder or club official or persons acting under their authorisation shall ensure that prominent, clear and legible notices are displayed at all exits requiring customers to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the area quietly.

The premises licence holder or club official or persons acting under their authorisation shall ensure that noise or vibration does not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby premises.

THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM

No striptease, no nudity or no restricted film exhibitions shall take place on the premises at any time. The admission of children to the premises shall be restricted if the entertainment incorporates adult entertainment.

The designated premises supervisor shall not allow on any premises licensed for the sale of alcohol, children under 16 years of age, who are not accompanied by an parents or guardians.
