## Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

### If this premises licence authorises the sale by retail or supply of alcohol to members or guests:-

1. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relations to the premises.
2. In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children-
  - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
    - i. drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol) or
    - ii. drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
  - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
  - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
  - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-

the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or  
the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring:
  - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
3. The responsible person shall ensure no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
4. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

5. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at times when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his/her personal licence is suspended.
6. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence
7. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
8. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
9. The responsible person shall ensure that
  - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
    - i. beer or cider: ½ pint
    - ii. gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and
    - iii. still wine in a glass: 125ml; and
  - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

**If this premises licence authorises the exhibition of films:-**

10. Admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the British Board of Film Classification.

**If this premises licence details the use of door supervisors:-**

11. All persons employed as door supervisors must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

## **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule**

Staff will be trained on the requirements of the Licensing Act when they are recruited and given training in 'drugs awareness' as part of their induction.

SIA Registered door staff will be employed on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights from 21:30 hours. Door staff will be employed based on numbers and as per current SIA recommendations.

The garden area will be monitored on a regular basis to ensure control of noise.

Providing a 30 minute extension of opening hours after the end of the sale of alcohol will promote this objective as the last drink will be consumed less quickly, with access to the pubs facilities and the provision of non-alcoholic refreshment during this period.

The DPS will be a member of the Wellingborough Pubwatch so long as it exists.

We shall comply with all Fire Safety Regulations and Health and Safety Regulations.

Recorded music volume will be reduced to background level during the wind down period to create a mood change.

A notice will be placed prominently at the exits asking customers to leave quietly.

The conditions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply. Photographic proof of age will be required to be shown by anyone seeking to purchase alcohol who appears to be under 20 years of age.

No children under the age of 18 shall be permitted on the premises after 22:00.

During the provision of regulated entertainment, external doors and windows will be kept closed, except for access to and egress from the premises

Live and amplified music shall not be played after 11pm in the beer garden or other external areas

### **Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

Existing video surveillance and recording equipment to be used. Video tapes to be retained in a secure fireproof environment, for a period of 14 days and to be made available to the Police or Licensing Authority.

Maximum number of persons permitted 245. Provision of specific measures to ensure the monitoring of the number of persons entering and leaving the premises.

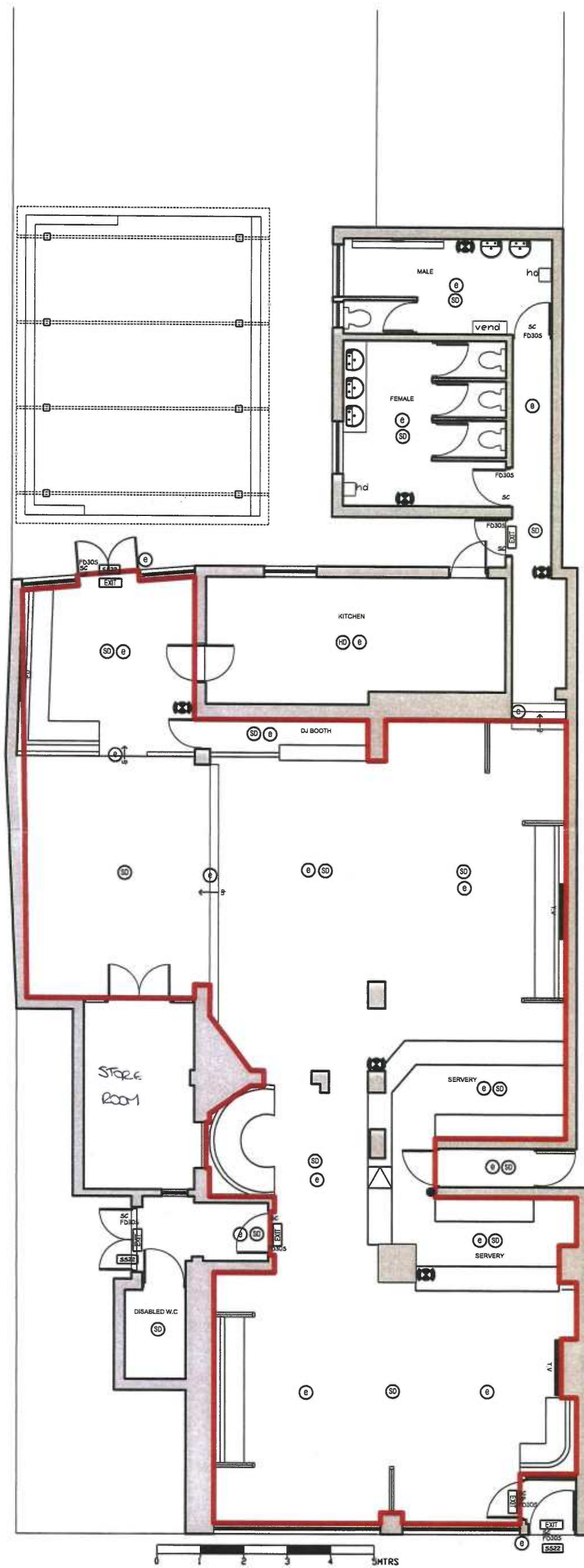
The Designated Premises Supervisor shall regulate the volume of music from the premises to ensure there is no likelihood of public nuisance arising to nearby residents.

No drinks shall be served in glass vessels after 2300 hrs until the premises closes on any day of the week, other than those sold in glass bottles

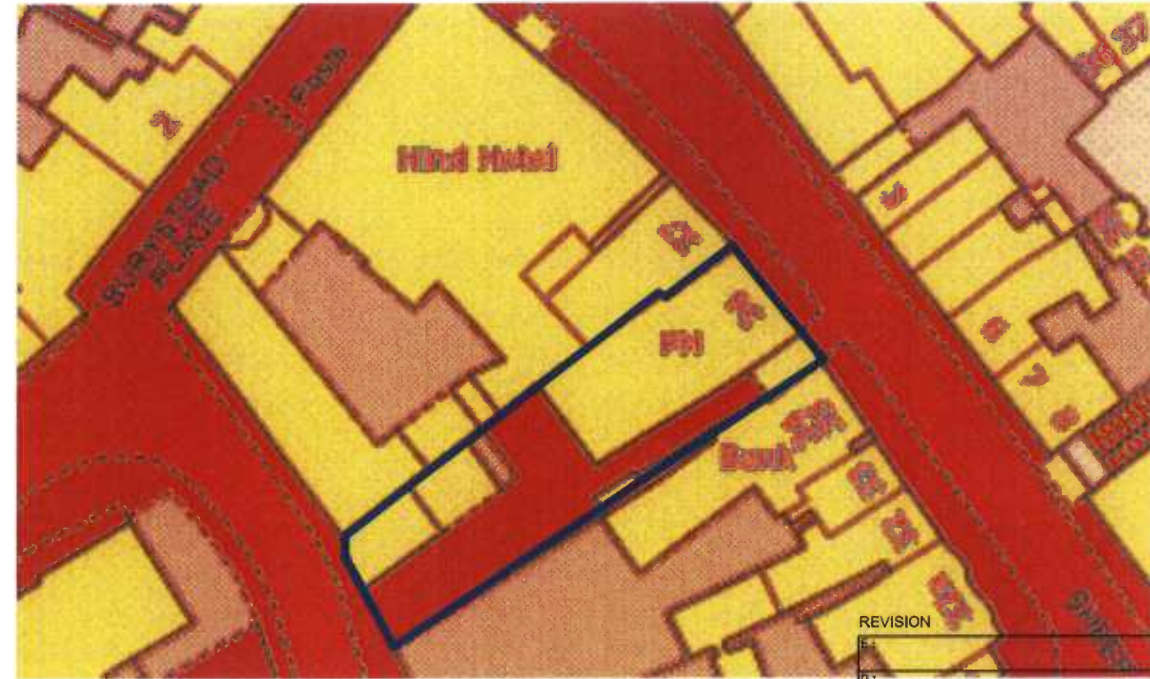
